

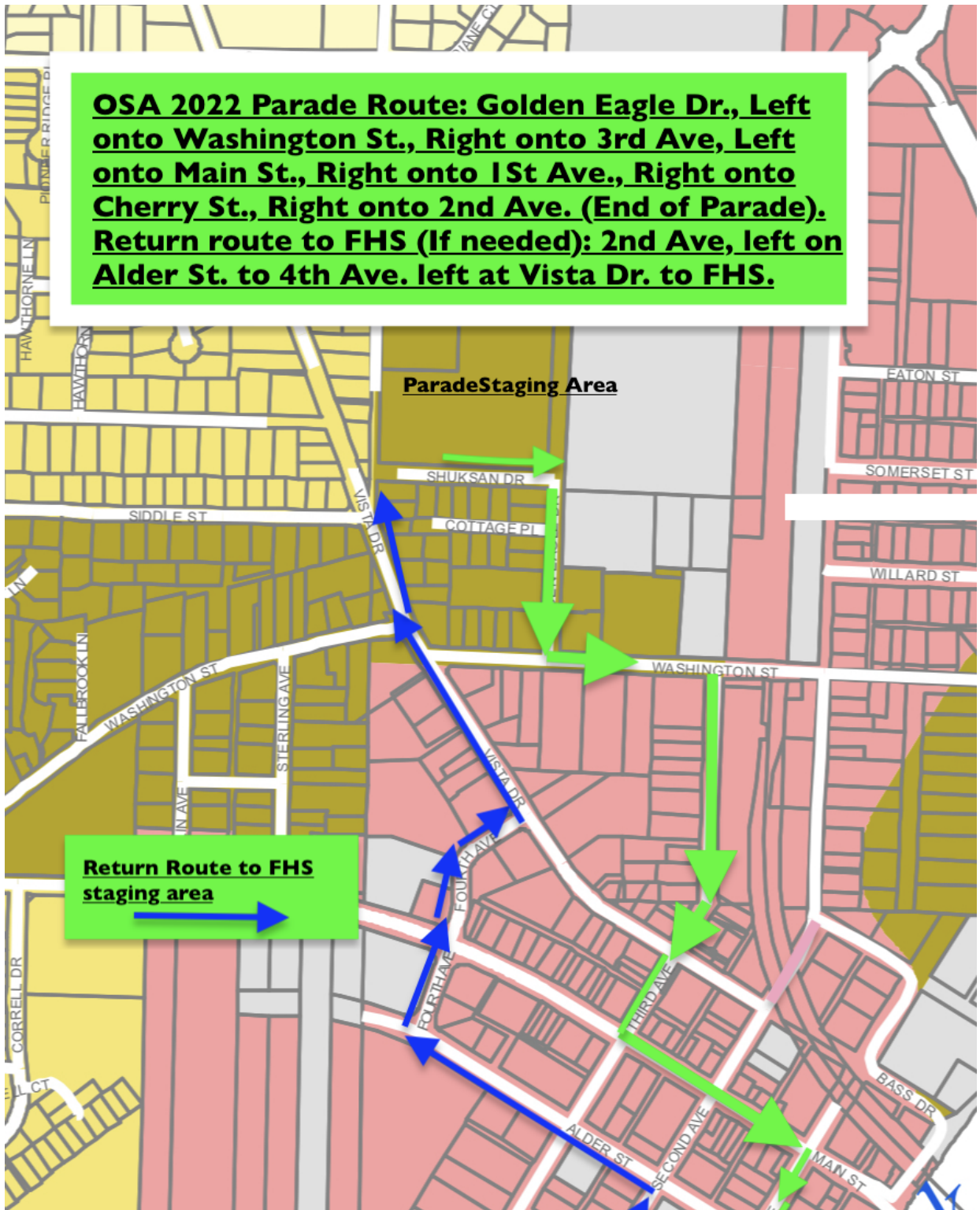

July 30th at the staging area (Ferndale High School-see attached map) from 8:30 AM till 10:00 AM. Take the filled out form to the registration table and give it to an OSA Trustee. They will present you with a ribbon. Parade starts at 11: AM. To go onto the parade route you will show your ribbon to another trustee who will allow you onto the route. We were looking for something simple this year. Recommended bring your own signage-we will not have an announcer this year. Have fun!

OSA 2022 Parade Route: Golden Eagle Dr., Left onto Washington St., Right onto 3rd Ave, Left onto Main St., Right onto 1st Ave., Right onto Cherry St., Right onto 2nd Ave. (End of Parade). Return route to FHS (If needed): 2nd Ave, left on Alder St. to 4th Ave. left at Vista Dr. to FHS.

Rules & Guidelines

Whatcom Old Settlers Parade, Saturday, July 30, 2022, at **11AM**. Participants of the parade start at the Ferndale High School parking areas. Approach the staging area from Vista Drive to Malloy Ave and look for a parade official who will give you instructions. After finding your location, you must take your **Hold Harmless Form** to the **Registration Table** located at the back side of the FHS cafeteria. Pick up your participation ribbon at this location. Bathrooms are available in the FHS Cafeteria north entrance. **Hold harmless form must be turned in no later than 10:30 AM on the day of the parade.**

Floats & cars: large parking lot staging area.

Single horses: In the back parking lot by the FHS Gym

Horse-drawn entries: On Shuksan St.- *as you go up Vista Dr. stay in the far-right lane. (A Parade Official will direct you).*

Owners must keep animals off school grass and all private property as you will be liable for any damage. With no exceptions, owners must provide clean-up for all animals, large or small. Thank you!

EACH PARADE ENTRY REQUIRES a signed Hold Harmless Form.

- Entries **will not be judged** for 2022.
- All floats must be **equipped with a fire extinguisher per code.**
- Horse entries should arrive no later than 10:15 a.m. Horse-drawn on Shuksan St., Singles in back staging area lot near FHS Gym.
- All entries must remain in their given position.
- Entries should try to keep with the spirit of the parade! Please keep entries and statements friendly and positive. (We're Back)
- Items may be handed out but **NOT thrown** to the public along the parade route (paper hand-outs, candy etc.)
- There is no fee for entries but purchasing a ribbon at the registration booth in Pioneer Park will help support our 100% volunteer organization and will be appreciated. Donations are also gladly accepted.
- After reaching Pioneer Park at the end of the parade, let people off the floats by the Boys and Girls Club on the corner of 2nd and Cherry St.
