Adults across Whatcom County participate in local Community Prevention and Wellness Initiative Surveys each year between July-November. The survey asks questions about adult perspectives as they relate to youth substance use, mental wellness and other topics that impact young people. This anonymous survey takes 5-8 minutes. 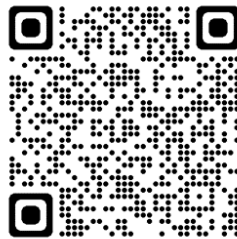
How does the data get used?

Local coalitions use multiple data sources to build our strategic plans, including the community survey. We use community survey data to prioritize funding and implement:

- Best-practice strategies that contribute to hope, positive childhood experiences and protective factors for youth
- Trainings to address emergent community issues
- Campaigns to inform and encourage healthy community norms and positive family communication, like the transit and social media ad shown here.
