WE RECOMMEND THE FOLLOWING STEPS TO HELP KEEP YOUR HOME SECURE.

KEEP YOUR HOUSE WELL-LIT AT NIGHT TO DISCOURAGE WOULD-BE CRIMINALS. SET INTERIOR LIGHTS TO COME ON AND GO OFF WITH TIMERS.

HAVE MOTION DETECTING FLOOD LIGHTS ON LOW-LIT AREAS AROUND YOUR HOME.

POST ALARM SIGNS ON THE EXTERIOR OF YOUR HOME. EVEN FAKE ALARM DECALS AND SIGNS CAN BE A DETERRENT.

STOP ALL MAIL, NEWSPAPERS, AND PACKAGE DELIVERY.

SECURE ALL WINDOWS AND SLIDING DOORS WITH WOODEN DOWELS, TO HELP PREVENT FORCED ENTRY.

BE AWARE OF THE TRASH YOU LEAVE ON THE CURB. BREAK DOWN BOXES FROM RECENTLY PURCHASED ITEMS LIKE TVs AND CONCEAL THEM FROM PRYING EYES. IF YOU ARE AWAY ON COLLECTION DAYS, HAVE A NEIGHBOR PUT OUT AND RETRIEVE YOUR BINS THE DAY OF COLLECTION.

NOTIFY YOUR NEIGHBORS OF YOUR DEPARTURE DATE AND YOUR RETURN DATE.
