Sealed bid proposals will be received by the City of Ferndale at Ferndale City Hall, 2095 Main Street, Ferndale, Washington, 98248, (360) 384-4006, until 10:00 AM on April 24, 2012, and will then and there be opened and publicly read for improvements of approximately 3,200 lineal feet of Main Street, from Douglas Road to Church Road. Work will include installation of 900 linear feet of sanitary sewer line; 5,000 linear feet of storm drain line; stormwater pond; and 800 linear feet of water main; installation of a 3 sided culvert; structural earth wall; removal of existing pavement, curbs and sidewalks; grading; placing gravel base and crushed surfacing; hot mix asphalt paving; installing curbs, gutters, and sidewalks; landscaping; and other work in accordance with the Contract Plans, Special Provisions, the Standard Specifications, including the amendments thereto, and Standard Plans.

All bid proposals shall be accompanied by a bid proposal deposit in cash, certified check, cashier's check, or surety bond in an amount equal to five percent (5%) of the amount of such bid proposal. Should the successful bidder fail to enter into such contract and furnish satisfactory performance bond and payment bond both in an amount of 100 percent (100%) of the contract price within the time stated in the specifications, the bid proposal deposit shall be forfeited to the City of Ferndale. All bidders and subcontractors shall have a contractor's license to work in the State of Washington and a City of Ferndale Business License.
