## A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FERNDALE DECLARING JUNE 2, 2018 TO BE "WEAR ORANGE FOR GUN SAFETY DAY"

**WHEREAS,** in 2016 there were 686 firearm deaths in Washington state, including deaths resulting from suicide and accidents; and

**WHEREAS,** a recent study at the University of Washington shows that only 36.6% of Washington gun owners store their household firearms locked and unloaded; and

**WHEREAS**, Ferndale and surrounding communities have experienced our own gun-related tragedies and near tragedies; and

**WHEREAS**, protecting public safety is one of the highest responsibilities of elected officials, and it is incumbent on us to be proactive in this pursuit; and

**WHEREAS**, we as a City must commit to do more to prevent unnecessary gun deaths and injuries, and to encourage responsible gun ownership to help keep our communities safe; and

**WHEREAS**, education is a key component of preventing gun-related deaths and accidents, and elected officials are compelled to make our residents aware of new gun safety resources available to them; and

**WHEREAS**, in March 2018 changes to RCW 9.41 received bipartisan support, which will allow people who believe they may become a risk to themselves or others to suspend their ability to buy guns from licensed dealers on a completely voluntary basis and with the ability to reverse their decision; and

**WHEREAS**, by wearing orange on June 2, 2018 we can raise awareness about gun safety, and honor and remember those who have lost their lives in firearm tragedies;

# NOW THEREFORE THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FERNDALE DO

**DECLARE** June 2, 2018 to be "Wear Orange for Gun Safety Day." We encourage all citizens to support local efforts to prevent the tragic effects of misusing a firearm, and to honor and value human lives.
