

#### **RECOMMENDATIONS:**

Staff recommends that Council adopt Six-Year Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) for the period 2022-2027.

#### **BACKGROUND:**

The City is required under RCW 35.77.010 (Perpetual advanced six-year plans for coordinated transportation program expenditures) to prepare and adopt a comprehensive transportation program for the ensuing six calendar years. Inclusion of projects on the six year list allows for funding applications as well as expenditures to occur.

It is important to note that inclusion of the Six-Year TIP does not necessarily indicate that a project will be completed within the six year period; however, a project must be included for the City to expend funds.

#### **ANALYSIS:**

RCW 35.77.010 requires that the City must adopt a revised six year transportation program before July 1<sup>st</sup> of each year. The program must then be submitted within 30 days to the Secretary of Transportation. Adoption of the TIP requires a Public Hearing, tentatively scheduled for June 7, 2021, for Council discussion and consideration.

With the City's major focus being the Thornton Overcrossing Project, which is anticipated to consume the majority of the City's project management resources during at least the first year of the planning period, the 2022-2027 TIP is substantially similar to previous years. Completed project removal and limited modifications to timeline, funding, and expenditure levels have been included.

It is anticipated that the City will be reviewing and modifying the 20-year project list included in the Transportation Element of the Comprehensive Plan to reflect current City development assumptions prior to the next required planning period. Development of the 20-year list will inform future versions of the six-year TIP as well as the formation of the Transportation Impact Fees charged to new development within the City.

Additionally, City staff and consulting traffic engineers anticipate the Thornton Street Overcrossing project will have a dramatic impact on traffic patterns within the City. Due to the unknown nature of future traffic patterns and changing development assumptions, City staff is not recommending substantial modification to the TIP at this time.

# <u>ALTERNATIVES CONSIDERED:</u> The alternatives considered include:

- 1) Proceed with the adoption of the Six-Year Transportation Improvement Program.
- 2) Take no action.
- 3) Direct modifications to the TIP.

**CONCLUSION**: Staff recommends adoption of the 2022-2027 Six-Year Transportation Improvement Program. A public hearing and consideration is anticipated to be scheduled for the June 7, 2020 Council meeting.
