We use multiple data sources to build our strategic plan, including the community survey. We use community survey data to prioritize funding and implement:

- Trainings to address emergent community issues
- Campaigns to inform and encourage healthy community norms and positive family communication, like the transit and social media ads shown here (at left and below)
